### Step 1.

#### Complete Army training course

Once training is complete, you can choose an ILM qualification that will complement your achievement and that employers will really value. Make sure you set aside time after your training to start your application process.

### Step 3.

#### Get your unique ASO reference number

The ASO process will produce a UFN number within eight weeks. Make sure you keep this checklist close to hand to help you keep track.

### Step 5.

#### Receive your qualification and certificate

Your qualification certificate will be sent to your home address. Once received, you'll be able to prove you're the best to any employer, wherever your career takes you.

### Step 2.

#### Choose your ILM qualification

Complete the Army Skills Offer (ASO) application form or visit [i-l-m.com/army](http://i-l-m.com/army) to see the wide range of qualifications available to you. Choose the qualification that matches the level of CLM training you have completed.
